abstract = nouns that are ideas, like realism, modernism, fantasy, and etc.


concrete = nouns that are tangible, you can do something with them, like person, floor, ball, dog, etc.


## What is a pronoun?

#### A word that replaces a noun.


# What are the types of pronouns?




