A person, place, thing, or idea

What is a common or a proper noun?

general noun

A proper noun is more specific

What is an abstract or concrete noun?

abstract = nouns that are ideas,
like realism, modernism,
fantasy, and etc.

concrete = nouns that are
tangible, you can do something
with them, like person, floor,
ball, dog, etc.
