<u>Date - Title</u> (2 points)
Grammar/Entry Copied & Corrected (2 points for copying it; 2 points for corrections)
<u>5-n-5</u> (5-60 points)
Answer/Definitions-Sentences/Chart w/ labels
<u>Reflection or Refl.:</u> (labeled, 1-2 sent., 3 points)
Reflection written as complete sentences
<u>E.T Choice # (</u> 5 points)
 Answer to E.T written as complete sent.

Eng. III & IV Journal Entry Guidelines

- 1. Date & Label/Title your entry and each section.
- 2. Copy the entire entry.
- Correct the grammatical errors, spelling, punctuation, etc. Keep your journal until we discuss it as a class. Make any other corrections as necessary.
 Write down the vocabulary term from the sentence with its part of speech and definition. Then, correctly use the terms in a sentence. OR Answer the journal prompt, writing for the ENTIRE time given.
- 5. Reflect write 1-2 sentences about what your writing made you think.
- 6. Keep your journal and write your EXIT TICKET in it.
- 7. Return your journal to the proper storage place.
- 8. Write your next entry under your previous entry. Use as little paper as you can - you'll be using this journal all year, and will fill the ENTIRE notebook.
